1.0 WHAT IS A CASE STUDY?

1. Case studies are a representation of real-world problems, and it helps both the potential recruit and future employer reconcile their strengths. It helps the employer gauge if the recruit has sufficient capabilities to:
 - I. Self-Learn
 - II. Problem Understanding
 - III. Passionately Problem-Solve
2. The case-study-method helps one understand real-world problems and helps the potential recruit to focus on what's essential, ignoring the noise to concentrate on what matters most to solve the problem.
3. The case report is evaluated based on the following **4 criteria's**

3.0 PROBLEM STATEMENT

Your high school wants to organise remedial classes for 10 poor and disadvantaged students. They also want to provide financial support for these 10 students to afford school uniforms, bags and other essential school supplies. They need USD1,000/monthly for their important project for the start of their 2024 school year.

To achieve **USD1,000** sustainably, they wish to rent their additional facilities every weekend (only) between **8am – 12pm**. They have a cost of **USD100/per day** to maintain the facilities.

Part I:

As a web developer can you assist the school with a user-friendly booking system?

Part II:

Appreciate if you can also consider creating a poster as well as advising the principal with a social media plan to get the booking of the facilities started.

Here is the list of rental facilities:

Option 1

1. Swimming Pool x 1
2. Football Fields x 2

Option 2

1. Tennis Court x 3
2. Slazenger Tennis Balls x pack of 3's

Option 3

1. Volleyball Court x 3

Extra Workflow Tips

1. Research a common booking/court reservation system
2. Pick 1 OPTION or combine the options as you wish!
3. Replicate it in Google Form (**turnaround within 3 days is expected**)
4. Think about breaking the booking system in different sections of forms. It will be communicated via a poster on the school FB page.
5. Research for competitor court pricing to give the school a competitive advantage (*consideration: potentially slash of 20% - 30% of rental fees*)
6. Pull them all together & present a working system, poster, and a creative social media plan (pick 1 best option) to the school principal.
